Description (max. 100 words)	Acquiring clinical psychological knowledge about individual aberrant behavior of people which is specified by the criteria of DSM IV and ICD 10. Students are introduced to dysfunctional mental states and processes, as well as personality disorders, etiologically classified as exogenous symptomatic and reactive personality states. Emphasis is put on studying and independent exploration with the use of nomothetic and idiographic techniques of nosologic categories of various forms of neurotic disorders and personality and behavioral disorders. Students acquire both theoretical knowledge and practical and exploratory experience that are necessary in the work of a clinical psychologist.				
Learning outcomes (max. 50 words)	At the end of the course, students are able to: identify aberrant and unadapted experience and behavior, i.e. to perform counseling and referring to adequate forms of therapeutic treatment; to perform effective assessment of mental status and to apply appropriate techniques in the diagnostic process as well as in steps that precede or constitute the precondition of the therapeutic process; to work in institutions dealing with mental health of people; to provide secondary clinical psychological intervention preceding the psychotherapeutic process, that is, to work in the institutions for partial hospitalization.
